


The services that we offer to study abroad advisors, faculty and students include:

SAMPLE LOCATIONS AND FACILITIES

The capital city of Trento



The **largest urban center in Trentino** (120,000 inhabitants) is the seat of major academic institutions, museums, services, businesses, and innumerable points of interest. It is **centrally located and well connected** with the rest of Italy, Austria and Germany. Students and faculty can be hosted in a **variety of accommodations**: hotels, guest houses and, during the summer, self-catered university dormitories. It is an ideal location for programs in all academic fields, and for groups that prefer **a livable urban setting**.

The lively Garda Trentino region

A small urban area (40,000 inhabitants) on the northern shore of the major lake of Italy, Lake Garda: **a Mediterranean pocket in the Alps** with a unique landscape and a world-class outdoor and sport scene. All major services are available in the area, which is also a renowned destination for European tourists. Participants are hosted in family-run hotels and self-catered apartments, and can enjoy the new facilities of the local campus of our partner **LABA**, an independent college of art and design. It is an ideal location for programs in all academic fields, in **a vibrant and scenic setting**.

The historic hamlet of Canale di Tenno

A well-preserved **medieval village overlooking Lake Garda**, at a walking distance from a small alpine lake, and just a few miles from the urban area of Garda Trentino. It hosts the **Giacomo Vittone Artists' House**, a unique institution that operates as an art gallery, a studio, and a guesthouse. Participants are hosted in the Artists' House dormitories and, if necessary, in apartments and bed & breakfast inns. All basic services are available in the village, including a grocery store, bars, restaurants, and public transportation. It is an ideal location for programs in the fine arts, humanities, and environmental studies, and for portions of longer stays, in a **slow-pace historic setting close to major facilities**.

The protected area of the Adamello-Brenta mountain range



The **Adamello Brenta Nature Park** is one of the most valuable and appreciated mountain preserves in the world, and enjoys [multiple recognitions by UNESCO](#). Its facilities include the **Villa Santi Nature House**, a restored traditional rural building in the woods at an altitude of 3,900 feet. It is a LEED certified building with state-of-the-art facilities: bedrooms, classrooms, both indoor and outdoor laboratories. A full-board service based on local products is also available. The closest village and bus stop is only 0.7 miles away, and is reachable via a paved mountain road. It is an ideal location for programs in the natural sciences and environmental studies, and for segments of longer stays, in a **traditional and comfortable alpine setting**.


Day 25 Transfer to the Swiss National Park (2.5 hours); guided tour of the park
